Garrod, Sir Edward Archibald (1857-1936) London physician, educated at Oxford and St Bartholomew's Hospital. He was a pioneer (1909) in the study of inborn errors of metabolism including alkaptonuria, cystinuria and pentosuria. He succeeded Sir William Osler (1849-1919) as pegius professor of medicine at Oxford and wrote The Inborn Factors in Disease in 1931.
