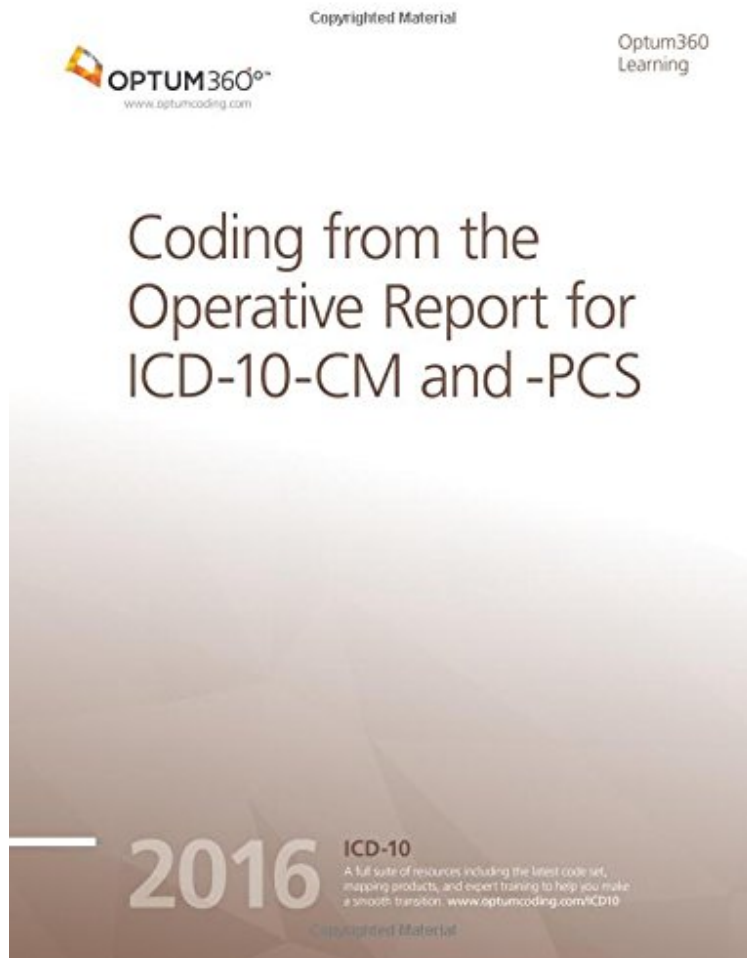

It is formatted such that the op note appears first with lines for your answers, followed by the same op note on the next page broken down into codes. ICD-10-CM diagnosis codes are utilized along with ICD-10-PCS procedure codes. NO CPT CODES are utilized in this book. The MS-DRG assignment is also given for each case along with rationale for code selection. Because I was particularly looking for orthopedic procedures, I will list below the procedures that appear in this manual:

- \*Percutaneous vertebroplasty with fluoroscopy.
- \*GSW with open fracture of right femoral lateral condyle and patella (exploration, debridement, fixation)
- \*Intradiscal electrothermal annuloplasty under fluoroscopic guidance.
- \*Knee arthroscopy with meniscectomy and debridement.
- \*Total hip arthroplasty.
- \*Anterior lumbar discectomy with fusion, bone grafting, and cage.
- \*Subtalar joint fusion with external fixation device.
- \*Arthroscopic SLAP repair with subacromial decompression.
- \*Resection of rib for osteosarcoma with chest wall reconstruction.

Definitely more complicated procedures than appear in your typical coding manual though a tad bit on the expensive side.
