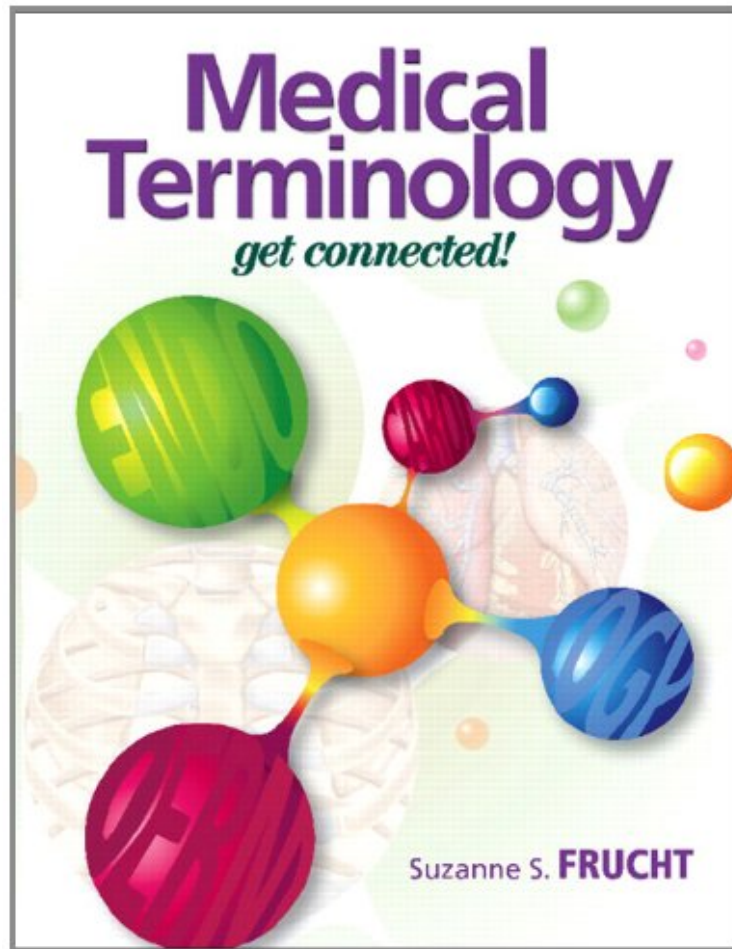

The book starts off by teaching you basic "root" words in the first few chapters and then moves on to explore a new medical field with each new chapter (example: Oncology, Urology, Neurology, etc.) and terms that would most likely be seen with each. Plus it contains plenty of written exercises to practice putting terms together or being able to recognize terms in the medical field by breaking down their "root" words.
