The other quick study was just better organized for AP even the Med Term class. But don't think this isn't a good index, it is. Its just that the first couple pages cover material that I don't really need. Ie: the sections on numerical values or colors or pathogens (not as helpful as it sounds). The small sections on surgical procedures diagnostic procedures were helpful but basically the entire first 11/3 pages were minimally helpful sometimes even at odds with the word roots we learned/used. The last 2 1/3 page glossary was great. There's also a section on Synonyms that made my flash cards much easier to remember after I studied that section for a little while. Basically, you may want to buy both this quickstudy Medical Terminology: The Body as long as you understand there will be significant duplication. Keep both or whichever one suits your needs best. Both ran under \$10 total here on . If you can only buy one(mind you, I'm still recommending buying both), I'd probably recommend the other one for those of you taking Medical Term., Human AP 1, Human AP2.
