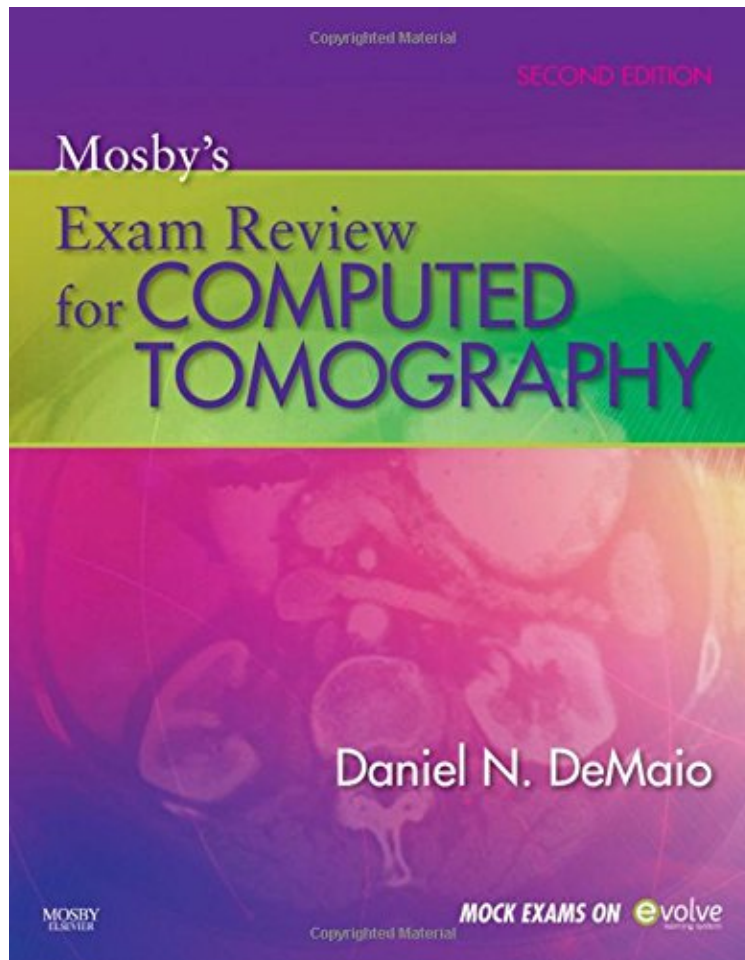

Lots of test questions in book, and online (which is how you will be tested with the ARRT), and answers provided. You will pass with just this book. Cons: While it has anatomy, it does not have enough to feel confident, you would need to find a supplemental source, as the ARRT had images of slices where I had no clue what I was really looking at. No pathology, while not required for the exam, it is a helpful aspect when providing services to patients. The procedures in scanning are divided into sections, but to find windowing levels, preferred injection rates, or delays, it gets frustrating trying to dig through the text for that to put on a straight forward cheat sheet to review on the go. You will pass, but it does not mean you will get respect from more knowledgeable techs who expect more from others, but that depends highly on workplace culture.
