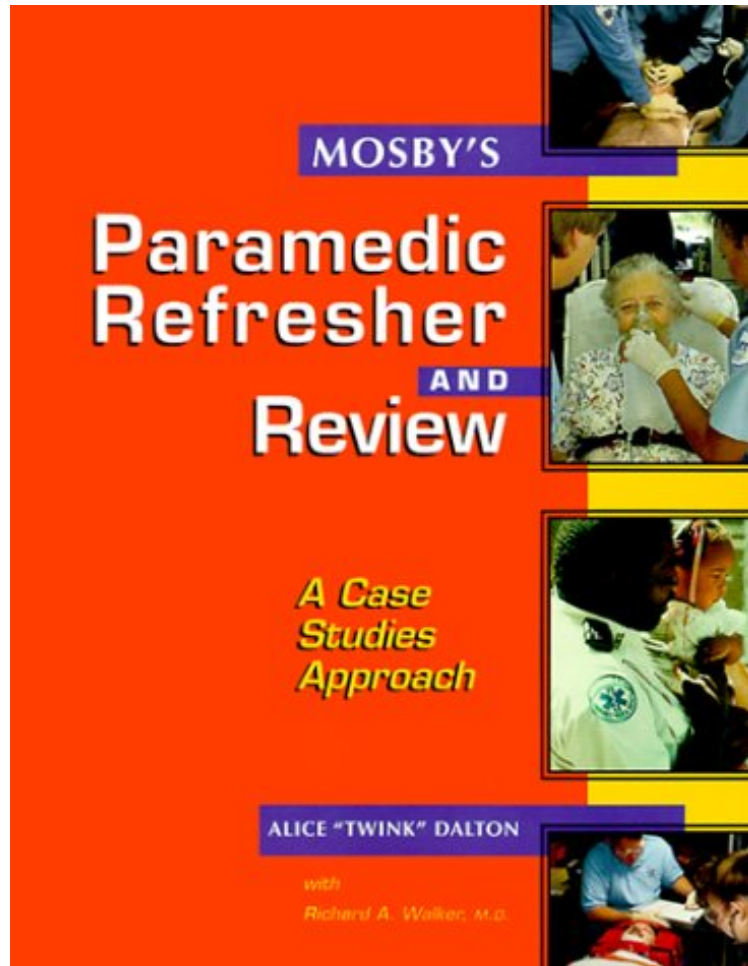


Mosby's Paramedic Refresher and Review: A Case-Studies Approach, 1e
