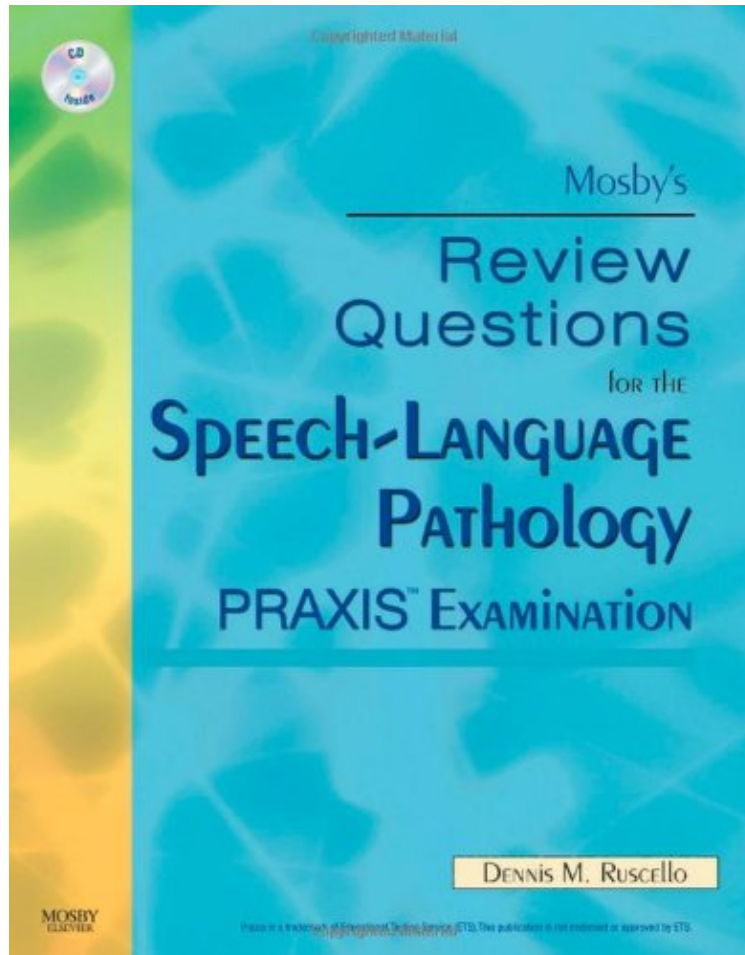

I would take about an hour a night to go through a section and answer questions. I liked that the book was split up into sections by content (ex. fluency, dysphagia, language, etc). Obviously the questions do contain content
