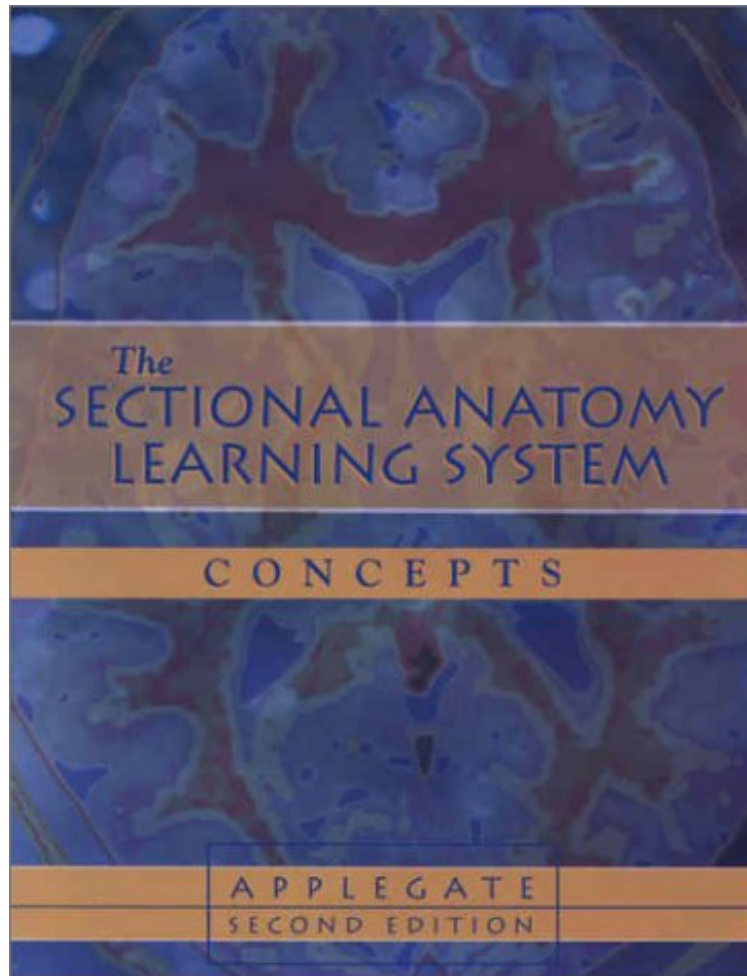

The orientation went against all of my training as a radiology and ct tech, since the image orientation was not

consistent.(the right should ALWAYS be the right, doncha know?) I do not recommend it to imaging professionals, as there are better books out there, but it might be ok for medical students or the like.
