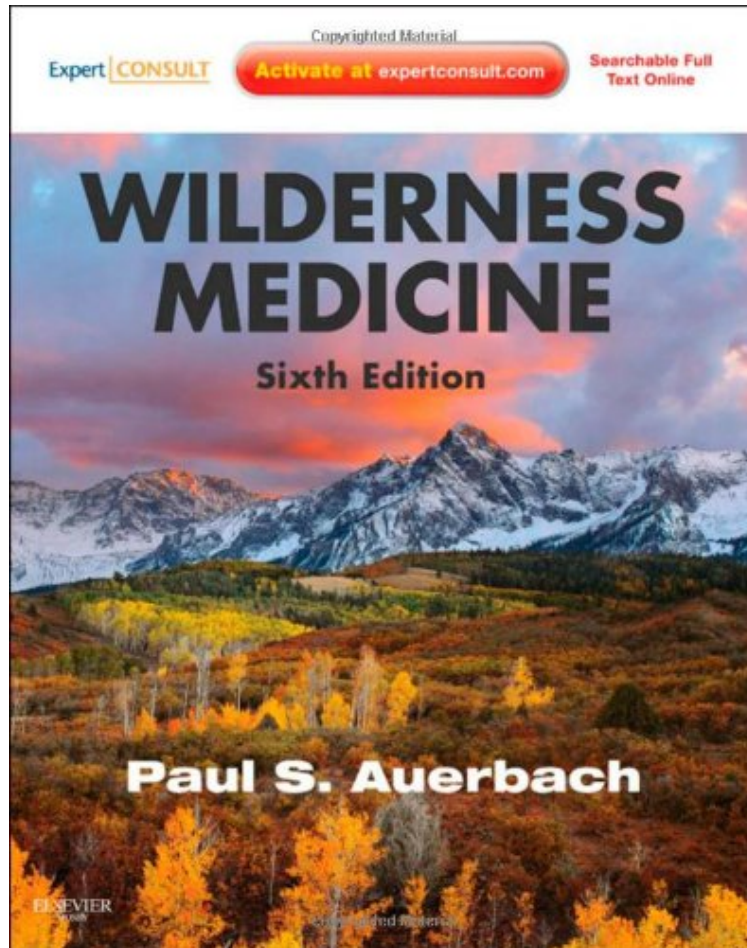

Health concerns and treatments for all wilderness environments are covered in great detail. The section on poisonous plants alone is worth the price of the volume. Instead of relying on vaguely recognizable drawings the book includes well curated photographs of the plants for easy identification. I put off buying this book for years because of the price tag which is admittedly steep but I am so happy to have it now.
